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# Optimized Engagement

Mastering Pass/Fail Scenarios in EdTech

This is a project I completed that highlights the intricate work involved in creating engaging and effective text for a math product in the edtech industry. It showcases the careful handling of pass/fail scenarios, and how they were integrated into the product to optimize student engagement and learning outcomes.

# Company & Product Overview

This work represents UI text that I wrote for an edtech company that offers learning solutions for children from preschool through 12th grade. The product is a program that teaches students in grades 3 through 8 how to do math. I wrote the following text for a mastery check that evaluates students' comprehension of a given lesson.





# Objectives

- Create UI text that introduces students to the mastery check, informs them of their success or failure, and leads them into the next activity.
- Create 3 sets of text to be used by different grade levels (K–2, 3–5, and 6–8).
- Use language that is encouraging and supportive so as not to discourage their continued efforts.
- Encourage students to reach out to their teachers for additional support.

# Requirements

- ➔ Use clear language that guides students through the mastery check.
- ➔ Use vocabulary and syntax that does not exceed the lowest grade level for the set.
- ➔ Keep students engaged through fun language choices.



# Content Structure

I needed to write copy for all of these scenarios:

1. **Introduction:** "Mastery checks are higher stakes than other activities, so we want to prime the students to do their best."
2. **Failed Mastery Check:** "When a student fails a mastery check they will be directed into instructional content. We want to use growth mindset strategies to encourage them to keep working."
3. **Lesson Passed:** "When a student passes any mastery check they will have passed the lesson. We want to celebrate the hard work they've put in to accomplish this."
4. **Second Failure:** "When students have completed all lesson content and still fail at the last mastery check, they will not be gated. They can continue on to the next lesson, but we want to encourage them to work with their teacher to get the offline help they need."
5. **Toaster:** "Toasters are to be added at random throughout the lesson when a student gives a correct answer."



# Minimizing User Fatigue

To minimize fatigue, I wrote multiple options for each set of copy that could be selected randomly.
